**MINUTE: GRANTS 029/11/10 – DONATIONS for 2011/12:**

The Clerk had provided Members with details of all the Grant Applications which had been received. These were discussed individually

**(i). Burial Committee** - It was agreed unanimously that the Burial Committee received the £4000 which had been requested. The Clerk informed Members that this contribution would be met solely by Barnton Parish Council as the Joint Agreement with Anderton & Marbury Parish Council expired in April 2011

**(ii). Parish Plan Implementation Group** - The Clerk pointed out an anomaly of £500 between the amount of Grant been asked for and what they proposed to spend the Grant on. It was eventually agreed that the Grant for 2011/12 be set at £2000

**(iii). Barnton Cricket Club** - It was agreed unanimously that the request for a £250 Grant towards the purchase of a “Bowdry Drying Machine” be approved

**MINUTE: GRANTS 029/11/10 – DONATIONS for 2011/12: (CONTINUED)**

**(iv). Barnton Memorial Hall** - The Memorial Hall had requested a Grant of £7500 and had produced two Grant requests which varied slightly mainly due to the removal of £2000 in the first request for a contribution to a reserve fund which would have been outside the scope of Section 19 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976. The 2nd request had incorporated this into the running expenses for 2011/12. A discussion then ensued on the request and it was agreed that £7000 the same as for 2010/11 be awarded

**(v). Barnton Wanderers Youth Football Club** - The Youth Football Club had made a request for a Grant of £3000 which was an increase of £1000 over 2010/11. Following a discussion it was agreed unanimously that the Grant for 2011/12 be the same as in 2010/11 at £2000

**(vi). Barnton Silver Band** - The Silver Band had made a Grant request for £1000 and it was agreed that this be awarded

**(vii). Barnton (MAD) Youth Club** - The Youth Club had made a request for £10,000 which was the same as last year. Ms. Kirsopp stated that she would rather see the Grant used to provide a fund for for a permanent home than spent on the Activity weekend however it was agreed that the £10,000 be awarded.
