



**MINUTE P&RG 046/03/10 – RECREATION GROUNDS:**

- i) Grange Road:  
The Clerk reported that he had applied to CWAC requesting that the Parish Council assume responsibility for the Play Area, subject to relevant maintenance monies being transferred to the Parish Council NOTED
  
- ii) Nursery Road:
